It is important to keep your Boerboel puppy lean and on the right track. We are not opposed to raw feeding however that is not something we proclaim to have a bunch of knowledge about. If you would like to feed BARF/RAW we would refer you elsewhere for more information. It is of the utmost importance when feeding a growing Boerboel to pay attention to the calcium, phosphorus, and protein. With the protein being lower on the priority list:

- Calcium, approx. 1.0-1.2%
- Phosphorous, approx. 0.8-1.0%
- Protein around 23%



You will find that not all bags of kibble will have the calcium and phosphorous listed. That is when someone must call the manufacturer and ask them. Be sure to get the minimum and maximum. We do not mind helping you at all. Proper nutrition is crucial to your puppies' joint health.

Here is a list of some foods with reasonable protein, calcium, and phosphorus amounts:

- ❖ Next Level Chicken & Brown Rice 24% protein
- Next Level Salmon & Rice Skin & Coat 24% protein
- ❖ Next Level Ocean Catch Skin & Coat 24% protein
- ❖ Next Level Lamb & Brown Rice 24% protein
- SPORTSMIX Wholesomes (Large Breed) 23.0% protein, 1.0% calcium, and 0.80% phos.
- ❖ Diamond Grain Free Whitefish and Potato 24.5% protein, 1.0% calcium and 0.8% phos.
- ❖ Fromm Large Breed Puppy 25% protein, 1.2% calcium, 1.0% phos.
- ❖ Innova Large Breed Puppy 24% protein, 0.9% calcium, 0.7% phos.
- ❖ Wellness Super 5 Mix Complete Health 22% protein, 1.2% calcium, 0.9% phos.
- ❖ Pride Pro series 21/17 21% protein, 1.2% calcium and 0.8% phos.

We have listed the brand and specific flavor variety. Other flavor varieties (meat flavors etc. not listed) may not have the appropriate values. Please keep in mind that not every food will work perfectly for every puppy. You should not mix or switch foods around. Keep an eye out for skin irritations which could signify an allergy. If you notice any irregularities in your puppy's growth, please notify us right away. One thing to closely watch is his/her front pasterns (wrists). If they develop knots, sway back or turn in/out then please take a picture and send it to us. The nutritional values are what were listed at the time of inquiry. It is up to you to note any changes with the food; you choose to feed your puppy.

Do not go stocking up on puppy food... We STRONGLY recommend switching your puppy to a high-quality Adult/ALS (All-Life-Stages) (large/giant breed formula) dog food at **12 weeks old**. We recommend Next Level All Life Stages dog food and NuVet vitamins. Anything over 26% protein is absolutely HORRIBLE in the first year, as it can cause severe skeletal development issues with certain bloodlines. We feed 24% Adult from **12 weeks** on and strongly recommend it.

#### Transitioning your Boerboel Puppy to New Food

If you have a puppy that is under 6 months of age, you should make the feeding transition quickly so as **not to disrupt their growth patterns**. This should be done in **3 meals or less** using a high-quality line of food. We like the Nature's Domain (Costco or Sams Club) or Purina Pro Plan formula, each support growth very well.

**Puppies:** Start with 50% old food and 50% new food and sprinkle your Probiotics on top of the food to smooth transition. The Probiotics can be **NuVet Plus** or Purina FortiFlora Probiotics. **And make the transition over by the third or fourth meal.** 

**Adults:** start with 25% new and 75% old food and use probiotics (**NuVet Plus**) but take 2-3 days to move over to new food totally.
